



Can I stop using a grazing muzzle?

The decision to use, and subsequently remove, your horse's muzzle should be a decision about your horse's health. Your vet can test your horse for metabolic issues that increase laminitis and colic risk, and help you determine when it's safe to remove a muzzle.

TEAM (Training, Education & Mentoring) Program

Training4Teaching Program

Intended to help professionals in**how** to teach (vs what to teach).

Weekend Equestrian Program

For riders of all ages, levels and disciplines; parents; trainers; and judges. The Weekend Equestrian Program seeks to include everyone from the horse community and to offer horse- and rider-related seminars on many topics.

Summer Intensive Training Program

For aspiring young riders ages 25 and under who are committee to achieving excellence. Participants have a full schedule of learning that includes fitness, theory, tests, riding lessons, lectures, and field trips.

Winter Intensive Training Program

For aspiring young riders ages 25 and under who are committed to be the best they can be. This program takes determination, drive and passion. The goal of the Winter Intensive Training Program is to give opportunities for youth riders to participate in consistent and extensive training not only in riding, but in all areas of horse care, riding and training theory, and competition skills.

Youth Dressage Festival

The Festival offers individual and team competition for riders from ages 4 through 25. Division championships feature a three-phased competition: a written test, a dressage test, and equitation. There are now three Festivals - the Youth Dressage Festival Midwest in Michigan, Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival in New York, and the Atlanta Youth Festival in Georgia.
