- type in your first and last name (as used on your entry form)
- answer all the questions
- hit the "submit" button when you are ready to submit your test
- please ensure you receive the automatic confirmation email indicating that your test was successfully submitted before you leave the testing location

The D4K Christian Kennedy Training Grant
