I learned so much this year and last year. Some of the things I learned during my lesson are always put your eyes where you want the horse to go, and be sure to not throw your horse off balance. I think this made me really have to think about the test instead of just the letters. I think this was really helpful for my focus.

While I was watching other people's lessons I learned to let your horse's head up so they can see, your horse does not need to overbend just be sure they don't counter bend and that some horses will not drink when stressed.

One of my favorite parts of the clinic are the new people I met. Autumn, Mya and Londyn were so awesome and kind. They were always encouraging me and asking if there was anything I needed help with. I hope to see them every year.
