Letter from Lendon Gray

Welcome riders, parents, trainers, friends and relatives to the 25th Annual Youth Dressage Festival!

Dressage4Kids™ is celebrating its 25th Anniversary this year! What began as a vision to provide better educational and competitive opportunities for youth riders has evolved into a multifaceted organization that offers a wide range of opportunities for both youth and adults.

My original inspiration for Dressage4Kids™ stemmed from my experiences at the 1988 Olympics, where I noticed the lack of structured programs for developing dressage riders in America. In one of my journal entries from those Olympics, I wrote: "From watching the training of so many athletes and talking to them about their long-term training, I'm amazed that no one has set up some sort of program to develop young riders of Dressage in America – where riders would not just ride and compete, but [take part in] programs set up to develop general fitness, suppleness, strength, and mental preparation off the horse; lunging of the rider; books [and reading theory]; lectures; and video to truly understand what they're doing. It seems like such a waste to let our Dressage riders develop in such a haphazard manner. To do this even on a small scale would be so great – there is so much that could be done to bring up educated athletes as riders. It seems that we [as a country] could be so much better and the time to do it is as teenagers before riders get in a situation such as I'm in where one struggles full-time for survival."

With that vision in mind, Dressage4Kids™ started with one program, Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival (then called the Northeast Junior/Young Riders Dressage Championships), which tested a rider's knowledge in three areas (dressage, equitation, and a written test based on pre-assigned reading).

That one program has now developed and expanded across eight programs, touching the lives of thousands of participants, including not just youth but also adults.

As a leader in the sport of dressage, Dressage4Kids™ is building the pipeline for the future. Over the past 25 years:

- over 115 horses have been donated through the D4K Horse Donation Program
- over 200 athletes have graduated from the D4K Winter Intensive and Summer Intensive Training Programs
- over 500 trainers have participated in the D4K Training4Teaching Program
- over 2500 riders have participated in D4K TEAM Program clinics
- over 3000 youth and adults have expanded their education through the D4K Unmounted Programs
- over 5000 competitors have competed in the Youth Dressage Festivals (Georgia, Michigan and New York)
- over \$500,000 has been awarded through D4K Scholarship Programs

In the words of a D4K participant: "Joining Dressage4Kids has been a life-changing experience for me. It has taught me so much about the sport, introduced me to amazing people, and provided me with incredible opportunities. I am forever grateful for the impact Dressage4Kids has had on my life."

Looking ahead, Dressage4Kids™ remains dedicated to developing programs that educate and contribute to the development of the riders, teachers, trainers, judges, and mentors of the future.

Letter from Lendon Gray, continued

Thinking specifically about this show:

Congratulations to the winner of our art contest, Maya Daniel from Alpharetta, Georgia, whose artwork is on the program cover. I love this part of our show. Our programs are always fun and unique.

Thank you to all the many wonderful volunteers over the years. Conducting this event is a year-round process, and we couldn't do it without our amazing volunteers who work hard before, during, and after the show to help create an unforgettable experience for everyone.

Thank you to all of the generous sponsors. We are incredibly fortunate to have the support of so many individuals and organizations, which make our activities possible. Please don't hesitate to express your gratitude to them. A special thanks to the sponsors who have been with us for 25 straight years (Theresa Davidson, Wendy Luscombe, and Trafalgar Square Books), and to those sponsors who have been with us for 10 or more years (Sam Grunkorn, Rhinebeck Equine, The Cheshire Horse, and The Horse of Course).

Please make sure that our wonderful equines are first and foremost in our plans. Do what you can to make sure that they have a comfortable, clean, quiet stall with water at all times; remember that part of what makes our show special is that it is based on horsemanship, which means putting their health and comfort first. Their feeding schedule should be as close as possible to what they have at home. Take them for a graze when you can. Don't sit on them and use them as couches. If you aren't actually riding, get off and hold them. If the weather is hot, find ways to keep them cool. We have stable managers walking through the stables checking on everything. Feel free to ask them questions.

Please watch out for each other and for fellow competitors – drink lots of water and don't wear coats if it's hot. The judges do NOT want to see you struggling with the heat under a coat.

Let each one of us do everything we can to make this a great few days for everyone.

Take a moment now to think about what needs to happen for you to have fun, and then you take responsibility to make it happen for those around you. This might involve helping a fellow competitor or a volunteer with their work, thanking as many people as you can, cheering up someone having a tough day, helping your child learn how to lose graciously, seeing a problem and coming forth to help solve it. I hope everyone will say as they drive out the gate at the end of the show, "Wow, that was a fun few days!"

For those who take home medals and ribbons, my heartiest congratulations. For those who maybe don't have their best days of competition, hey, that happens to all of us. I hope you have fun anyway. I had some really disastrous competitions in my day but still made two Olympic teams. The one dressage test sheet I have kept from all my years of competing is the one where I got a 38%! There are lots of ways to win: Overcome a difficulty, be a super sport, have your horse stand still in the halt for the first time, do your first test ever in the pouring rain, keep smiling even though you just did the worst test of your life.

My hope is that each of you goes home with a new friend, a new technique for your riding, and wonderful memories.

Letter from Lendon Gray, continued

Here are some additional notes for you to remember this weekend:

*Despite our best efforts, we cannot guarantee a perfect sound system, so please help out. This means planning ahead, reading all notices, and especially passing on any announcements you hear to everyone you run into. Check the bulletin boards regularly.

*Once again, each rider is expected to be prepared to get to the proper ring at the proper time. Our stewards are there to try to keep things safe and to let you know if the ring is running early or late. They are not there to tell you when you go, or who you are after, etc. Have a piece of paper in your pocket with your ride time and the numbers of the three riders are ahead of you; Make sure you let the steward know that you are there. The stewards will tell you when you may go around the competition arena. They will not go looking for you or yell out your number. It is your responsibility to be ready.

*If you do not have a trainer and would like help with your warm-up please check at the office or find Lendon.

*Any bicycle rider endangering or annoying horses, riders or pedestrians will be banned from riding their bicycle on the grounds. The same goes for golf carts. Remember horses and pedestrians have the right of way over bicycles and golf carts. Ride slowly please. There are to be NO bicycles in the barn aisles or by the doors into the barns.

*Only licensed drivers may drive golf carts.

*Parade of teams – please respect parents and sponsors and dress in riding or team attire.

*Check for any schedule changes on bulletin board after 7 a.m. each day.

*There is no value to continually asking when scores will be posted!

*If you have any special requests or you question a score you must go to the Appeals Committee: contact Fern Feldman.

*Remember to thank the volunteers and your parents!

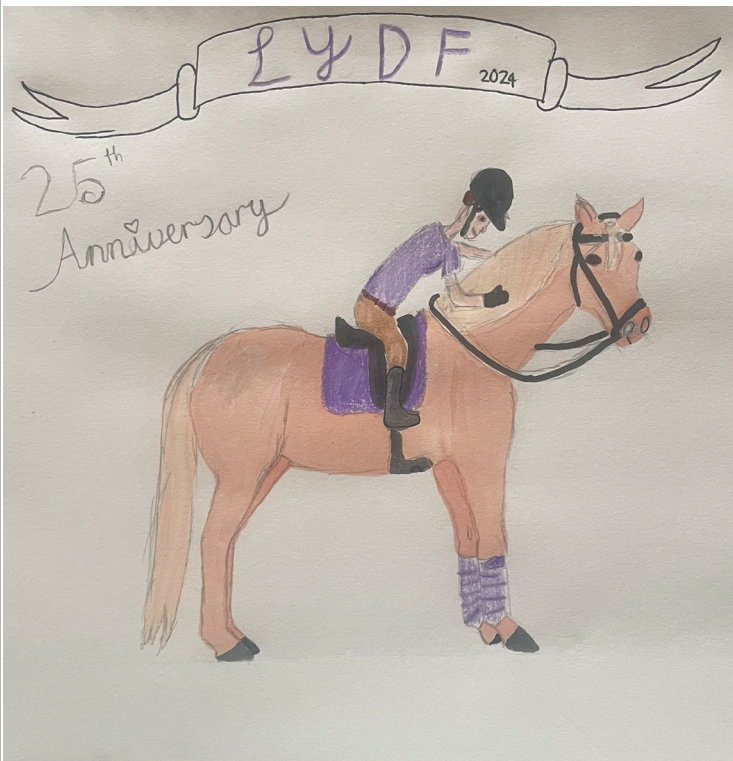

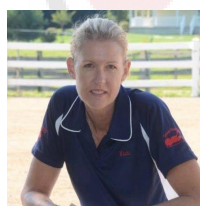

Rules

Competitor's Volunteer Requirement: All competitors MUST volunteer for at least 1 hour during the show. Once you have arrived and have your horse stabled, get your packet from the Show Secretary, check your ride times, and then go to the Volunteer Booth for your assignment(s). Competitors need to know their ride times and warm up requirements before coming to the volunteer booth to sign up for their volunteer hour. Parents may accompany the competitor but may not sign up for them.

Attire: Riders may wear traditional show attire. Informal attire (short or long-sleeved polo shirts; no tee-shirts) also is acceptable in the performance arena in place of traditional show attire. Teams may want to have matching shirts. All riders must wear proper attire when mounted. ASTM/SEI-approved helmets are required for ALL riders when mounted. Helmets will also be required for all Handler Class entries and those handling the demo horses for the Sport Horse Conformation Class. The wearing of an improper helmet, including an improperly fitted helmet (e.g. loose chin straps), is grounds for disqualification. Whips and blunt spurs are allowed. Judges may deduct up to two points for messy attire in the performance arena. Award recipients must be in neat competition attire (unmounted) to receive their Division awards.

Bridle Numbers: Horses must wear a bridle number at all times when out of the stall.

Tack and bits must follow USEF dressage rules with the exception of Prix Caprilli classes. Bits used in competition must be the same bits used in the warm-up immediately preceding the competition. Draw reins are not permitted at any time on the show grounds. Horse boots and/or polos are allowed in warm-up areas. The Show Management reserves the right to inspect any rider and their equipment at any time for compliance with these show rules. Non-compliance will be grounds for disqualification.

Schooling is permitted only when the show office is open and after the rider has received their number. Trainers may school competitor horses only on Wednesday and Thursday and must sign a release at the show office prior to riding. Any violation may result in disqualification of the competitor.

Coaching: No coaching is allowed any time while the rider is competing. Any rider receiving coaching while in the competition ring will be disqualified, whether or not the rider requested such assistance. Any visual, verbal, or other communication with the rider is considered coaching.

Readers are not permitted for the Schooling Show on Thursday or the Dressage/Equitation Classes on Friday. Readers are permitted for the Prix Caprilli, Dressage Trail, and Quadrille classes only.

Lunging is permitted only in designated lunging areas.

Parking is permitted only in designated parking areas. After unloading, trailers must be parked in the RV / Long-term Parking for Trailers area. Car parking is permitted in "blue reserved parking" spaces only. Illegally parked cars will be towed at the owner's expense.

Golf Carts: May only be operated by licensed drivers and may only be driven and parked in designated areas.

Warm-Up: Ground helpers (coaches, parents, etc.) are not allowed in the warm-up ring and must stay outside the fence. To adjust tack, please exit the warm-up.

Dogs: Must be leashed, accompanied by a responsible human, and kept quiet in stabling and riding areas.

Bikes: Must be ridden safely and slowly in vicinity of horses and parked out of horse traffic areas.

An adult must supervise all young children at all times.

Infractions of any rules may be cause for elimination or up to a 5-point penalty at the discretion of management.

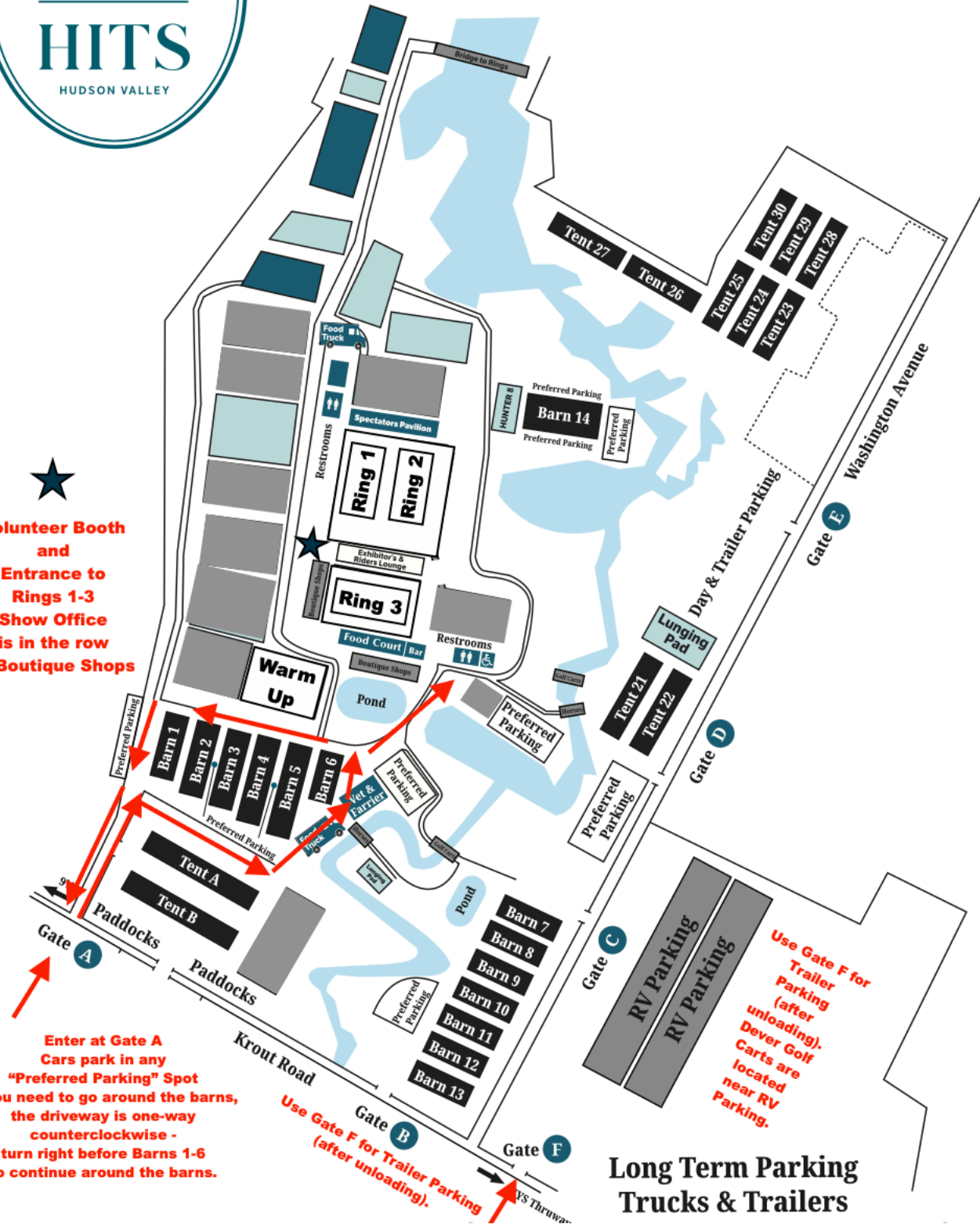

Youth Dressage Festival

Code of Conduct

All participants, including riders, trainers, and parents, are required to abide by the following:

- Sportsmanship is developed through good manners and a commitment to fair and friendly competition.
- Sport should reflect courage, patience, good temper, and unselfishness.
- Sport is fun and is meant to be enjoyed by all.

Welfare of the Horse

The welfare of the horse comes first. Riders and trainers are responsible for ensuring the welfare of the horse throughout this event. Stable management will be inspecting stalls to ensure that they are clean and there is ample clean water, and that the horses are comfortable.

Arena Protocol

- Only one ground person per rider is allowed.
- Spectators should watch from the bleachers.
- The ground person should stay on the wall.
- Check in with the ring steward upon entering.
- Leave the on-deck area promptly after finishing your test.

Courtesy Counts

- Keep your eyes up for other riders.
- Call out where you are going, if needed.
- Pass left hand to left hand and with enough room.
- Circles and diagonals should be ridden off the track.
- If someone is having a problem, give them the right-of-way and plenty of room.
- Don't halt on the track to make adjustments.
