

Horse Donation Program – Each horse or pony is matched with a rider who agrees to keep the horse or pony forever. The happiness of all is our premier tenet.

Weekend Equestrian Program – an annual two-day educational seminar held in Connecticut for riders of all ages, levels, and disciplines; parents; trainers; and judges.

Scholarship Program – Thanks to its partners and sponsors, Dressage4Kids has developed a scholarship and professional development program.

TEAM Program – a national program for dedicated, determined young dressage riders of all levels, ages 25 and under. The goal of the program is to find, to help to educate, and to develop talented youth to become the international riders and trainers of the future.

Training4Teaching Program – a national program intended to help current and up-and-coming professionals in HOW to teach. The goal of the program is to provide opportunities for our professionals to become better teachers and mentors.

Winter Intensive Training Program – for aspiring young riders that are committed to being the best they can be. The goal of the program is to give opportunities to youth riders to participate in consistent and extensive training not only in riding, but in all areas of horse care, riding and training theory, and competition skills. This program is conducted annually in Florida from January - March.

Youth Dressage Festival – the Festival offers individual and team competition for riders from ages 4 through 21. Division championships feature a three-phased competition: a written test, an individual dressage test, and a group equitation ride. There are currently three Festivals held in Georgia, Michigan, and New York.
