

Through field trips, guest lectures, and the best instruction, riders of any level and experience can grow to become the best dressage riders they can be.

D4K Youth Dressage Festival – the flagship event of Dressage4Kids, the Festival offers individual and team competition for riders ages 4 through 25. Division championships feature a three-phased competition: a written test, an equitation ride, and an individual dressage test. Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival is an annual event held in the Northeast. An additional Festival is held at the Georgia International Horse Park in Georgia.
