The criteria for the scholarship include – exceptional talent, proven ability to work hard, demonstrated ethical behavior, horsemanship skills, and the consistent drive towards stated goals. Scholarship recipient Brynne Varvel has all of these attributes and more.

Dr. Angela Blackwell writes, "I have known Brynne for several years and watched her develop into a lovely young rider who is very focused on the needs of her horses. As an equine veterinarian and chiropractor with a special interest in sport horse and rehabilitation, I examine a lot of equine patients, and the horses always tell the real story. Brynne is a 23-year-old young professional from Bloomington, Indiana. She began riding at five years old and competing in dressage at age 11. She is currently a USDF Bronze and Silver Medalist with notable placings at both USDF Regional Championships and the USEF Festival of Champions. Not content to just ride, Brynne graduated with a Bachelors in Management from Indiana University in 2021 and has also completed Part 1 of the USDF L Judge Education Program, with plans to complete Part 2. Brynne currently trains out of her family's KWPN breeding farm, Varvel Sporthorses, where she also helps raise the next generation of prospects in addition to coaching local students.
