Horse Donation Program – *Each horse or pony is matched with a rider who agrees to keep the horse or pony forever. The happiness of all is our premier tenet.*

Scholarship Program – *Thanks to its partners and sponsors, Dressage4Kids has developed a scholarship and professional development program.*

TEAM Program – *a national program for dedicated, determined young dressage riders of all levels, ages 25 and under. The goal of the program is to find, to help to educate, and to develop talented youth to become the international riders and trainers of the future.*

Training4Teaching Program – *a national program intended to help current and up-and-coming professionals in HOW to teach. The goal of the program is to provide opportunities for our professionals to become better teachers and mentors.*

Weekend Equestrian Program – *an annual two-day educational seminar held in Connecticut for riders of all ages, levels, and disciplines; parents; trainers; and judges.*
