### **Competitor Volunteer Requirement**

All competitors must volunteer for at least 1 hour during the show. After you have: 1) arrived and stabled your horse, 2) received your packet from the Show Secretary, and 3) checked your ride times, go to the Volunteer Booth for your assignment(s). Competitors need to know their ride times and warm-up requirements before coming to the volunteer booth to sign up for their volunteer hour. Parents may accompany the competitor but riders must sign-up for their own task, including communicating to the volunteer staff.

### **Monitoring Equine Health**

Riders are responsible for monitoring their horse's health during the event. Riders are required to immediately notify the Show Office in the event of any clinical signs of disease and/or temperature above 102F.
