Tegan has also participated in the D4K Summer Intensive Training Program (SIT) as a stable management intern and has attended the D4K Winter Intensive Training Program (WIT) three times, once as a stable management intern.

Emalee Walker is a twenty-three year-old from Dallas Center, Iowa. Emalee grew up in a large family where horses were always part of life. Too young to join Pony Club alongside her sisters, she quickly learned that if she wanted to ride, she had to work hard and be resourceful. From riding a one-eyed pony she couldn't steer, to an Arabian who only had eyes for her sister, to starting her first off-the-track three year-old Thoroughbred at age 13, Emalee discovered grit, perseverance, and a deep respect for the process of learning with horses. At 16, her sister - also a dressage trainer - entrusted her with Grenade, a cheeky and opinionated partner who has become her greatest teacher. Together, Emalee and Grenade earned their USDF Bronze Medal and are now pursuing Silver while schooling the foundations of FEI. Their partnership has taken them across the country, working under top professionals and learning from some of the best in the industry. Emalee is stepping into her role as a professional rider and trainer. She has participated in D4K's

Training4Teaching Program and is committed to sharing her knowledge through teaching, furthering her own competitive career, and completing her academic education alongside her work with horses.
