D4K T4T (Training4Teaching Program) – to continue to support young riders, adult amateurs, and more experienced professionals on their paths to become better teachers and mentors.

D4K SIT (Summer Intensive Training) Program – a one-month overall education program for riders ages 25 and under. Riders have a full schedule of learning that includes fitness, theory, tests, riding lessons, and lectures on many pertinent subjects.

D4K UP (Unmounted Programs) – in-person and virtual educational events and learning opportunities for riders of all ages, levels, and disciplines; parents; trainers; coaches; and judges.

D4K WIT (Winter Intensive Training) Program – in Wellington, Florida, from January through March, the most determined, passionate, aspiring young riders can participate in consistent and extensive training in riding and all areas of horse care, riding and training theory, and competition skills. Through field trips, guest lectures, and the best instruction, riders of any level and experience can grow to become the best dressage riders they can be.

D4K Youth Dressage Festival – the flagship event of Dressage4Kids, the Festival offers individual and team competition for riders ages 4 through 25. Division championships feature a three-phased competition: a written test, an equitation ride, and an individual dressage test. Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival is an annual event held in the Northeast. An additional Festival is held at the Georgia International Horse Park in Georgia.
